## High School Clay Target League Wrap Up

The 2024 regular season for the Central/Logan High School Trap Team concluded on May 29th with their annual awards/fun night. The C/L team had 45 athletes on the team this season. Aquinas had 42 competing. Congratulations goes out to the top five from C/L. Aiden Schulze lead the team with an average of 24.60 followed by Faith Hellerud (23.8) Taylor Turner (23.50) Cowen Rueter (23.30) and tied for 5th place were Drew Hass and Cole Hasburgh (23.1). Aiden finished 1st in the conference and 3rd overall in the state. Honors for top female in the conference went to Faith, followed closely by Taylor in second. Aiden, Faith, Taylor and Cowen all took home top 100 finishes in the state. No easy feat, as there were 3475 athletes competing statewide this spring. Drew and Cole tied for 132nd place. Alexis Stupi was top female her conference, competing for Aquinas. As a team C/L finished 4th in their conference and Aquinas finished 5th in their conference.

The state tournament was held on Sunday, June 9th in Rome WI. Shooting conditions were less than ideal, with strong winds blowing the entire day. Aiden Schulze led the team shooting a 96, followed by Drew Hass (91) Taylor Turner (89) and Faith Hellerud (87). Alexis Stupi had a 97 and finished in 1st place for varsity female and 3rd overall in the tournament. Other top finishers for Aquinas were Luke Wrobel (89) Tucker Reyerson (88) Gabe Hundt (87) and Alanna Hurlburt(85).

Next stop for the team will be Nationals in Mason MI. Dates for this year are July 10th-14th. Aquinas will have Alexis representing their team. Once again C/L will have 2 squads competing for both team and individuals. Representing C/L on squad one will be Aiden S., Faith H, Taylor T, Cowen R. and Drew Hass. Samantha Oldenburg, Carter Beitlich, Aiden Martin, Josh Pepin and Benji Wood round out the 2nd squad. They will be competing with 1800 of the best individuals and 240 of the top teams in the nation. If you see any of these individuals, please congratulate them on their accomplishment. They all have worked hard to get to compete at the national level. This year they needed an average 19+ to even try to get in to compete. Just to show how tough it is to get into Nationals, the 3rd tier that our 2nd squad qualified for filled within 30 SECONDS! Yes, 30 seconds.

As a team we know that none of this would be possible with out the continuing support of the Chaseburg Rod and Gun. A special thanks to all the clubmembers who give hours of their time coaching and volunteering. Many of these members were at the club 10-12 days in a row. Not just coaching, but they were there for club clean up, meetings, team practices, the Aaron Hass Memorial Shoot, league and more. ## 4 Person Trap League – June 25<sup>th</sup>

The league starts on June 25. Last year, 100 men, women and teenagers participated in the league. The family aspect of the league is obvious, with a number of teams that included fathers and sons/daughters, grandparents, brothers, sisters, cousins, and in-laws. 25 teams were spread over 5 divisions, according to ability. Your team will be placed into a division of shooters with like ability. The prize money is the same for each division also, paying out 3 places. You must be a club member to participate. The cost of the league is \$135 for the whole season, which includes the entry fee, cost of birds, scorer's fee, and prize money for the 9 weeks of shooting. Shooting is each Tuesday starting at 2 o'clock, and you must be signed up to shoot by 8 pm. You do not need to shoot at the same time each week, or even shoot at the same time as your partner. Lunch is served also from 5 – 7 each week. It's always fun to get together and throw a little lead into the air! Hope to see you on the trap range!
