Dear Dan and Chaseburg R&G Members,

Thank you for the donation of \$1200 in support of the youth trapshooters in the Westby area. The money has been used towards starting our endowment fund with the Scholastic Clay Target Program, where we will be able to draw 5% annually to purchase shells, range equipment, and targets to further support youth trapshooting in the area. We will also be receiving three shotguns, gun cases, eye and ear protection and 12 flats of ammo just for joining the SCTP. These supplies are available to any youth shooter in the Westby area to shoot trap at your club, Westby Rod & Gun, and Coon Valley Conservation Club. If you know of any interested youth shooters needing a gun or supplies, don't hesitate to have them contact me.

On July 29<sup>th</sup>, we traveled to Waukesha for the 2014 Wisconsin State SCTP Trap Shoot. Enclosed is a picture of the squad that attended the shoot. From left to right is Blake Allen, Brady Rudie, myself, Bryce Rudie, Brenton Fleming, and Owen Gluch. The squad placed 4<sup>th</sup> in their division of 28 squads with a total score of 429/500. Bryce Rudie led the team with a score of 91/100. Next year I hope to take at least two squads as we had over 13 youth that attended practices on a regular basis.

We've wrapped up practice for the year and I have encouraged the shooters to visit your club to shoot through the remainder of this summer and fall. Next spring we will kickoff the season as soon as the weather permits and build on our 4<sup>th</sup> place finish.
