2026 3-D Archery Shoots

The dates for the 2026 3-D shoots are set for March 14 & 15 and for June 13 & 14. If you have not shot one before, there are 3-D animal targets set up through the woods at various yardages. There are scoring rings on each target, so the better your shot the higher the score. There are 3 stakes to shoot from, a challenge stake for expert shooters, a hunter stake at closer range, and the closest stake is for traditional shooters and beginner shooters. The event is kid-friendly also, where your youngster can take a shot from any range you are comfortable with him shooting. Binoculars and range finders are allowed. We have animal targets as large as moose and elk, and targets as small as skunks and raccoons. In between are deer, bear, turkeys, sheep, even a dinosaur and a cobra! It is strictly for fun; no prize money is offered. The cost is \$10 for adults, \$5 for ages 12 - 17, and free for kids under 12. Registration is from 7 am-2 pm each day. The shoots are open to the public. We also offer a family rate of \$25. There will be food and beverages available for purchase also.

Two & Four Person Trap League Dates

Start thinking about getting your teams together for 2026 and mark your calendars! The league is open to men, women, and kids 12 and over who have passed hunter safety. The two-person trap league will start on Tuesday, April 14 and the four-person trap league will start on Tuesday, June 23. These dates ensure that the leagues will be completed by the end of August. Details about the trap league can be found on our website, www.chaseburgrodandgun.com. Last year, the two-person league had 102 shooters competing on 51 teams. The four-person league had 88 shooters competing on 22 teams. The divisions are organized according to shooters ability so each division remains competitive. Cash prizes at the end of the leagues are equal for each division. You must be a club member to participate.

High School Trap

The results are in! The USA Clay Target League once again set record numbers with 55,832 registered student athletes competing in 2025. This marks 31 consecutive record-breaking seasons. There were 1,972 teams with 157 new teams added just in the past year. These numbers would not be possible without the commitment of 11,350 coaches and staff members. Teams from **Central/Logan and Aquinas** know full well the importance of our coaches and staff. From the start of our season planning in January, until the final shot is fired at Nationals in July, they are there. Our teams are very lucky to have so many volunteers dedicated to promoting this sport. Coaches/staff are at the club every Monday and Wednesday evenings from March until the end of May. The head coaches and staff work tirelessly behind the scenes. From ordering shells, organizational meetings, school open houses, athlete open practice shoots on Sundays, getting sponsorships to offset expenses, planning for the state tournament, set up room blocks and everything needed to compete at Nationals, the list is endless. Why do the coaches/staff volunteer to do this? It is the excitement on the face of that new athlete after breaking his or her first target. It is watching the improvement from week to week. It is the nervous tension at Nationals waiting to see if their score qualifies them to move on to the final day of competition. But most of all, it is teaching them a sport they can participate in for the rest of their life.

Aaron Hass Memorial 5th Annual 50 Bird Shoot

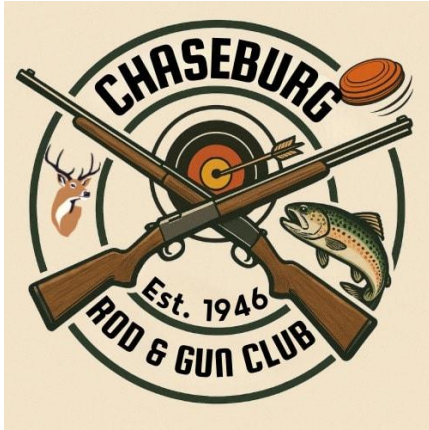
